

# BYLAW AMENDMENT PROPOSALS

During the August meeting of the Lodge Executive Committee, the leadership motioned and passed a proposal to add three (3) new positions to the panel of lodge leadership. Two of these positions will have seats on the Lodge Executive Committee and one position will be added to each of our Chapter Cabinets. The positions and their descriptions are outlined below. The proposed positions will be discussed and voted on during the General Lodge Meeting within our Fall Ordeal Fellowship.

**Service Chairman** (Program Committee) - Coordinates 3 OA service days at local Scout camp with Ranger Corps. Organizes projects and promotes OA camp service program. Helps to coordinate camp projects for Ordeal Fellowships and Winter Fellowship service. Takes charge of organizing the Lodge Service Award program.

**Lodge Elections Coordinator** (Administration Committee) - Directly coordinates with Chapter Chiefs and each Chapter Elections Coordinator to organize unit elections with local troops/crews and train Chapter election teams. Unit Elections Coordinator is responsible for working with election teams and Chapter Chiefs to input election results into LodgeMaster and keep record documentation from election reports. Elections Coordinator will give weekly updates to Chapter Chiefs and Chapter Elections Coordinators on newly requested unit elections via the lodge's election request form on the website. Coordinator will also maintain a record of units holding elections with each district/chapter and report data to the Vice Chief of Administration and Lodge Executive Committee.

**Chapter Elections Coordinator** (Chapter Cabinet) - Chapter Unit Elections Coordinator is responsible for promoting elections and camp promotions to units within their chapter/district. They are responsible for training and organizing chapter election teams and will communicate weekly with the Lodge Elections Coordinator on newly requested elections and will report all election business to the Chapter Chief and Lodge Elections Coordinator.

## ARTICLE IX: LODGE MEMORABILIA

### SECTION G

#### Current

All Bob White Lodge insignia and specialty items will be sold only to Bob White Lodge members in good standing. One year after an event, the Lodge Executive Committee may authorize the sale of any Bob White Lodge insignia and specialty items in any manner or terms as it deems it advisable to encourage the liquidation of the excess inventory including to non-members.

#### Proposed Amendment

All Bob White Lodge insignia and specialty items will be sold only to Bob White Lodge members in good standing. The Lodge Executive Committee may authorize the sale of any Bob White Lodge insignia and specialty items in any manner or terms as it deems it advisable to encourage fundraising and/or the liquidation of the excess inventory including to non-members

All bylaw amendment proposals are approved by the Lodge Executive Committee and are introduced for discussion at the General Lodge Meeting during the Fall Ordeal Fellowship. After the discussion, the proposal will be brought to a vote where all youth-registered Arrowmen will be able to participate in the ballot process.
